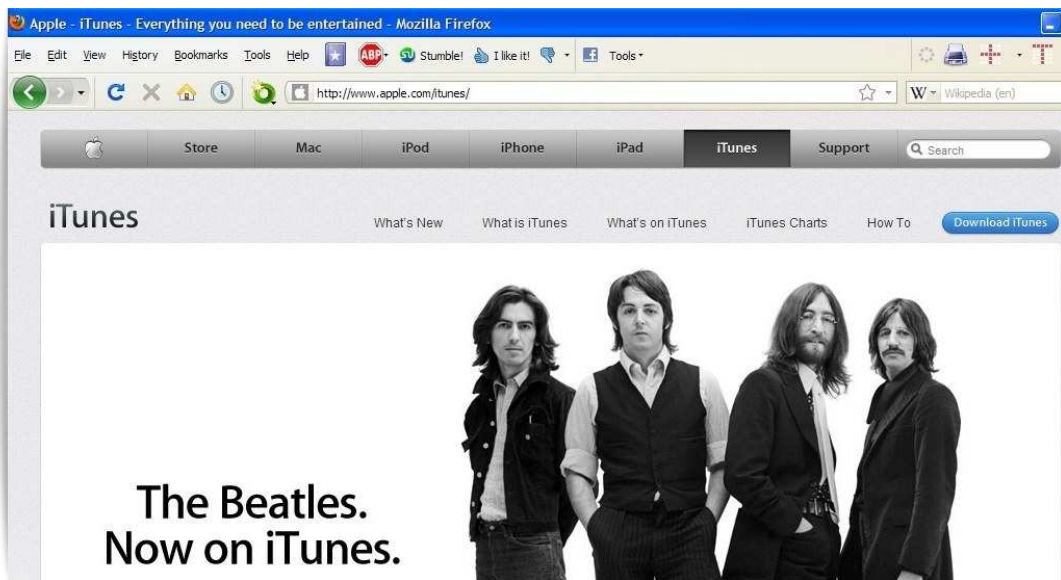




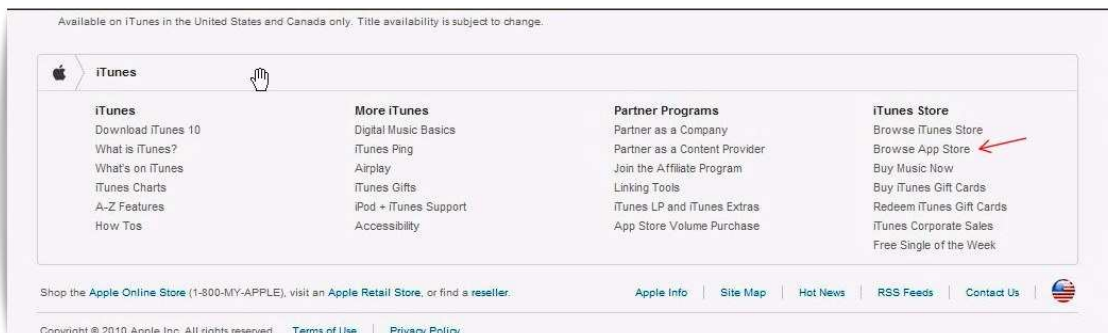
## How to Give an App as a Gift

Want to gift someone with an app from the Apple iTunes Store? It's easy to do. If you're gifting *San Francisco Waterfront: Bridge to Ballpark*, you can skip Steps 1-3 below by going directly to <http://bit.ly/SFWaterfront>. If you want to buy a different app (or just browse the app store) follow the steps below:

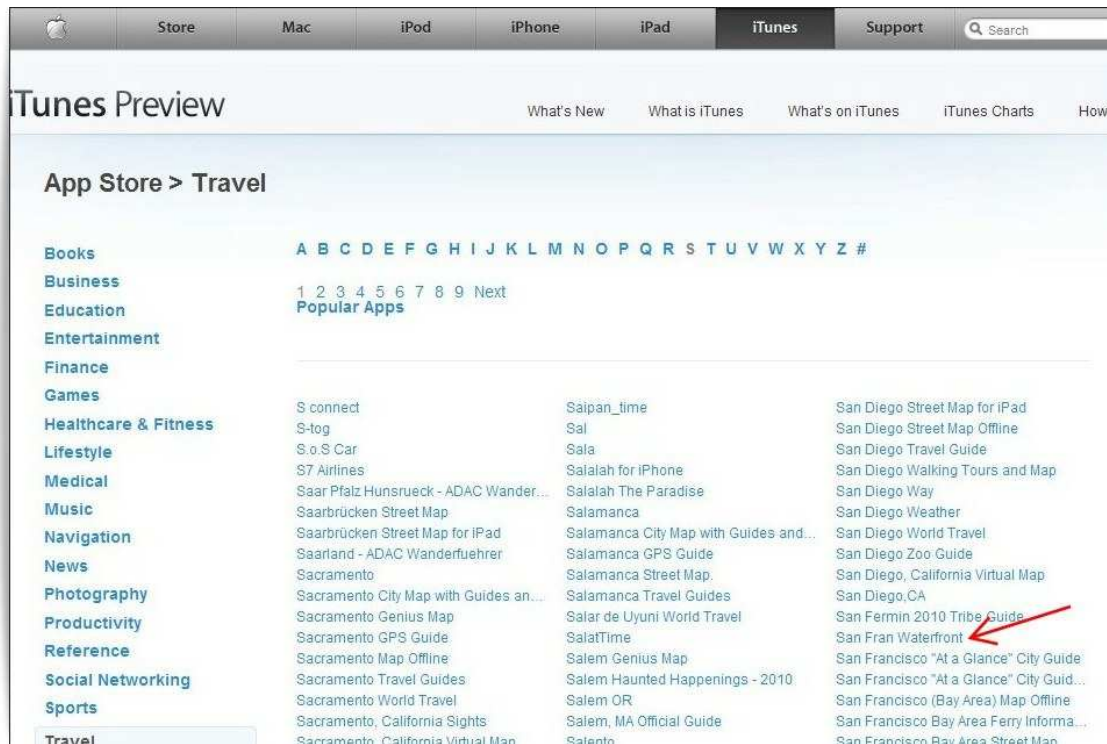
1. Use your computer visit the iTunes Store: [www.apple.com/itunes](http://www.apple.com/itunes). The photos on the landing page change frequently, so the page will probably look different than the one below:



2. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on **Browse App Store** in the column of links headed "iTunes Store."



3. Navigate to the app you're interested in and click on it. Here we've chosen **San Fran Waterfront** (short for *San Francisco Waterfront: Bridge to Ballpark*).



4. A page will open up with a description, screenshots, and user ratings (if available). On the left side of the page, just below the colorful app icon, is a blue button that says **View in iTunes**. Click on that button.



5. Now you're on a new page, and the button below the icon says **Buy App**. If you were going to simply purchase the app for yourself, you'd click **Buy App**.

However, since you're giving the app as a gift, [click on the little arrow just to the right of Buy App](#). Several options will appear in the drop-down menu (see smaller photo), including **Gift This App**. Click **Gift This App**. After purchasing the app with your credit card you can either print out the gift access code or send the recipient(s) a personal email to let them know about the gift.
